- Sacramental confession, within about 20 days before or after
- Eucharistic communion preferably on the day, or the days before or after confession
- Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father
 - Our Father...
 - ❖ Hail Mary...
 - Glory be...
- In any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or
- In the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!")
